

Garret Lake Sediment Study RFQ Questions and Answers

- 1) Does the survey include reclaiming areas of the lake that have grown up over the years and are now above the water line?
 - a) Answer - the RFQ is for only the open water portions of the lake. The sediment study shall not include any portions of the lake that are above the water line.
- 2) Can the costs for returning to the site to remeasure be bundled in units of 10 with a separate mobilization cost?
 - a) Answer - yes the costs can be bundled with a separate mobilization cost
- 3) Can the electronic deliverable be in .dxf or .dwg format?
 - a) Answer - yes with a caveat. The deliverable shall show the sample location, water depth, and sediment depth. A digital contour map would be preferable or quoted as a separate line. The goal for the study is to be able to take the electronic deliverable and quickly perform “what if” dredging scenarios.
- 4) Should the contour map for water and sediment depths be a field run topographical survey tied to height above sea level elevations?
 - a) Answer - the survey shall show water depth and sediment depth to hard pan. The survey is not intended to be topographical. The point of reference for the measurements shall be the lake water surface. A tabular format of data is acceptable if it can be keyed back to the location map by sample number.
