**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MOUNTAIN PARK CITY COUNCIL REPEALING  
SECTION 117-25 OF THE MOUNTAIN PARK CITY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE  
PROCESS FOR ROAD ABANDONMENT, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, Section 32-7-2 of the Official Code of Georgia provides a procedure for the abandonment of municipal streets; and

WHEREAS, Section 117-25 of the City of Mountain Park, Georgia's code of ordinances provides a process for road abandonment which is not entirely consistent with the procedure provide by O.C.G.A. § 32-7-2;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council find the procedure provided by ordinance unnecessary in light of the mandatory statutory procedure;

THEREFORE, the Mayor and City Council hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE

Section 117-25 of Code of the City of Mountain Park, Georgia, pertaining to the Process for Road Abandonment, here hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION TWO

- A. **SEVERABILITY**. If any section, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance shall be found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalid language shall be severed and shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance, which will be enforceable to the greatest extent allowed by law.
- B. **REPEALER**. Any ordinance in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

C. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption.
