

**CITY OF MOUNTAN PARK
MILLAGE RATE HEARING AND
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
100 LAKESHORE DRIVE
AUGUST 15, 2018**

Mayor Still opened the public hearing at 7:01 for the purpose of discussing the 2018 tax millage rate. Present were Mayor Jim Still, Council Members Joyce Ayers, Don Carlson and Robert DeLaSalle. Also present was Karen Segars, Clerk/Administrator.

Still opened the hearing stating the proposed tax millage rate was set forth at 8.32 down from 12.88 from the previous year. He opened the floor for public comment.

Ken Gray asked if the upcoming budget included money for lake restoration. He further continued saying it was not too early to start thinking of ways to repair the lake and that said payment for repairs should be assessed like a property assessment. Still stated there were no funds included in the budget for lake restoration.

Still advised a referendum would be on the ballot that would allow a cap on future property assessments not to exceed 3%. Guy Sutton confirmed it would be on the November ballot.

There being no further comment, Still opened the Special Called meeting at 7:08 p.m. to set the tax millage rate.

Carlson moved to set the tax millage rate at 8.32. 2nd by Ayers. Approved 3-0-0.

There being no further business, Carlson moved to adjourn. 2nd by DeLaSalle. Approved 3-0-0. 7:09 p.m.
