PUBLIC HEARING AND SPECIAL CALLED MEETING

The public hearing was opened at 6:38 p.m. by Mayor Jim Still, Jr. Also in attendance were Council Members Rob Belser, Don Carlson and Scott Mills. Clerk/Administrator Karen Segars was also in attendance.

Segars advised the rollback rate had been computed to 12.88 based on the information given by Fulton County of the values of Mountain Park. She noted a reduction in real and personal property, as well as motor vehicles. Segars added that discussion was ongoing between the city's accountant and Fulton County to verify the numbers.

Still opened the special called meeting at 6:54 p.m.
