

Know Your City Code



Article 2-Division 4- *Section 62-147*: Trash Containers

(d) Approved containers shall be placed at the edge of the person's property, immediately abutting the city's street, before 7:00 a.m. on the regular assigned day of the city's waste management services. Such approved containers at curbside may in no event be placed before 6:00 p.m. on the day prior to collection day and must be removed from the curbside no later than 8:00 a.m. on the morning following the assigned day of collection.

(e) At all times when the approved container is not permitted to be at the curbside pursuant to subsection (d) above, the container must be stored outside of the public right-of-way and at least ten feet away from the edge of pavement.

Article 2-Division 1: Noise Ordinance

Section 113-42- General Prohibition

- It shall be unlawful for any person to make, continue or cause to be made or continued any loud, unnecessary or unusual noise or any noise that unreasonably or unnecessarily annoys, disturbs, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others in the city.

Section 113-45-Enumeration

- **(2) Construction or repairing of buildings.** It shall be unlawful for any person to operate or permit the operation of any tools or equipment used in construction, drilling, or demolition work on weekdays between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., such that the sound therefrom creates a noise disturbance across a residential real property boundary, except for emergency work of public service utilities or by special variance. No home construction shall be allowed on Saturday or Sunday except for construction between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.
- **(9) Loudspeakers; amplifiers.** It shall be unlawful for any person to use, operate, or permit the operation of any loudspeaker, public address system, mobile sound vehicle or similar device amplifying sound therefrom on a public right-of-way or public space for any commercial purpose. Further, it shall be unlawful to use, operate, or permit for any noncommercial purposes any loudspeaker, public address system, mobile sound vehicle, or similar device between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. on weekdays and between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. on weekends.

1. Must provide proof of residence in the City of Mountain Park.
2. ONE TRUCKLOAD OR TRAILER LOAD PER RESIDENCE.
3. All yard debris must be cut into 3 feet sections or less.

Please note that this is a service provided by Waste Management as a courtesy and the City of Mountain Park does not have any control over what time they arrive/depart or the rate which the dumpster fills and the amount it can hold. Please plan accordingly. Thank you!
