Mayor Still called the meeting to order via Zoom at 2:33 p.m. Present: Mayor Jim Still, Jr., Council Members Don Carlson, Linda Dixon, Lloyd Hendricks, Mark Murphy, and Carol Silver, City Attorney, Brandon Bowen and Clerk/Administrator Karen Segars.

Meeting Agenda:

Cherokee SDS Extension until October 31, 2020

Hendricks moved to authorize the mayor to sign the extension with Cherokee County and it's other municipalities for the Service Delivery Strategy. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dixon. Approved 5-0-0.

Discussion of COVID-19 Efforts in Accordance with State and Local Guidelines

Still advised he was working with the city attorney to prepare an emergency declaration ordering sheltering in place with the exception of essential activities. He further noted a curfew would also be in effect from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m. with the exception of essential activities. Still stated RPD and DNR would be assisting in patrol of park areas and violations would be a misdemeanor with a \$1,000 fine and/or up to 12 months in jail. He explained the public buildings/facilities would be closed; however, parks would remain open with no gathering of ten or more and social distance measures. Murphy clarified exercise was included in the essential activity definition.

At this point, the meeting was taken over by an unauthorized user and Mayor Still ended the meeting at 2:38 p.m.
