Carlson moved to adopt the agenda as presented. 2nd by Murphy. Approved 5-0-0.

MAYOR'S REPORT

Still noted the success of the Harvest Ball held by the Civic Club. Still stated the Sunday concert series on the green were proving to be a fun and announced the next to be a Bohemian revival and encouraged everyone to dress in the spirit. He also advised the SDS with Cherokee was still in progress.

COUNCIL REPORTS-None

CITY HALL REPORT

Segars advised the street signs had been cleared and cleaned with an order for a few replacements made. She noted fifteen letters had been sent to property owners about possible violations of the new ordinance regarding parking of recreational vehicles, trailers, and car restoration projects. Segars announced Rhyne's re-certification had been received by the state which was valid until June 30, 2021. She also stated the water system records had been updated with the DNR. Segars advised she had attended the TSPLOST meeting of all the Fulton County cities for status update and had been able to connect with Delaross from Roswell regarding the IGA revision which would be forthcoming.

Still announced the upcoming dates for meetings: Work Session, November 13, 2019, Regular Council, November 18, 2019 and Work Session, December 11, 2019 and December 16, 2019 Regular Council.

Carlson moved to approve. 2nd by Ayers. Approved 5-0-0. Ayers asked why one term was only two years. Brandon explained it was filling the unexpired term of Cooper. He also noted one other seat would be for two years which would be dealt with through legislation session next year so that the election cycles would be even with three/three seats up for election every two years. Still stated both Dixon and Hendricks had agreed to take the two year seats.

Robert Montgomery asked about the straw poll on the lakes options. Murphy stated he was giving a presentation at the "Meet the Candidates" meeting being held by the Civic Club on Tuesday, October 29.
